- New Hampshire raised RAINBOW AND BROOK TROUT are available in two sizes: 6"-8" & 10"-12"
- **All trout 6"-8" trout must be purchased in sets of 25 and must be picked up on April 21.**
- **50 fish minimum for all 10"-12" trout, but you don't have order in sets, you can order any number of 10"-12" trout greater than 50.** They will be delivered to your pond directly on Sat, April 21, 2018.
- If ordering both 10"-12" and 6"-8" fish, all trout will be delivered to your pond.
- Sizes and types cannot be mixed to meet minimum purchase requirements.
- Trout must be released into your pond as soon as possible. Transporting within a 45-mile radius of Brentwood is recommended.
- All trout come from a NH based hatchery that is licensed and inspected annually.
- Deliveries for any order (50+) of 10"-12" trout, will be **Saturday afternoon, April 21, between 1pm and 5pm. Since exact location of the pond must be given in order for delivery to occur, you must draw a map on the back of this order form, even if we have been there before.** Include a daytime phone number so we may contact you if we have questions about delivery.

General guidelines for stocking your pond

A ¼ acre pond with a depth of 8 ft. that is full all summer with fresh water may support 100 fish. The cleaner the water, the better, best to see 6ft down.

Surface temp not greater than 72°F at the hottest time.

Brook trout need cold water (@ 45° to 60° F); Rainbows tolerate warmer temperatures(@ 55° to 65° F); .

Best pH range is 6 to 7 (brook trout at lower end; rainbow at higher).

New ponds should not be stocked for at least one year.

Use floating trout feed in newer ponds until they are established.

Rainbow Trout

Rainbow Trout can tolerate warmer water (55-65 degrees F. is optimal) and tend to be somewhat hardier. The rainbow trout is gamier than the brook trout. They often leap from the water to strike a fly. They are excellent for eating.

Brook Trout

Brook Trout are native to eastern North America and require a year-round supply of cold, oxygenated water (45-60 degrees F. is optimal). The brook trout is generally considered the favorite game fish with its beauty, easy catchability and unrivaled table appeal.
